The dots on the posters for the 2024 Biennale are places to take a momentary pause from the hustle and bustle of the city, from the flurry of daily festival life: get off at Marienplatz, change focus, performance in the underground shaft.

The journey continues. A line: main line, directions, program line. We pick up speed. Colorful, interplaying lines transport us from A to B, maneuvering us through different worlds. Next stop: Muffathalle. Inspired by the New York subway look, the lines on the 2024 Biennale posters designed by Kolja and Jamal Buscher are actual sections from the Munich S-Bahn and U-Bahn network.

Finally, an aerial perspective. A surface: city map, performance area, film screen. If we look at it all from above, the hustle and bustle is put into perspective. Max-Joseph-Platz, Alte Utting, Isarauen: points on the Munich city map, the festival grounds. The Munich Biennale is beginning to peel off into the city - what is starting just now with posters will continue into site-specific performances in the urban space.
